MAP TESTING – JAN. 21-25

Grades K-8 will complete Fall MAP Testing during the week of Jan. 21-25. MAP, or the Measure of Academic Progress, is a computerized adaptive test which helps teachers and parents improve learning for all students and make informed decisions to promote a child's academic growth. We use this program in the fall, winter, and spring for monitoring student progress.
