Katy Smith is a teacher, a trainer, a keynote speaker, and an education advocate. A licensed parent educator, Katy has spent a career teaching at Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) supporting parents, caregivers, and providers and the small children they love in Winona and other communities. Katy has two undergraduate degrees in social work and in parent education from Winona State University. She has a master’s degree in Education from the University of Wisconsin, LaCrosse and a master’s degree in Early Childhood Public Policy and Advocacy from Walden University. Katy and her husband, Matt, live in Winona, where they raised three spunky daughters. They have recently welcomed three new sons-in-law and a baby grandson, Frank, into their family. Katy is the 2011 Minnesota Teacher of the Year, the first early childhood educator in Minnesota, and the first parent educator nationally, to be honored with the award.
