### **TUITION SCHEDULE FOR 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR**

St. John's Voters have approved a 4% increase to the school tuition fees for next fall.

Pre-Kindergarten tuition will remain the same. For grades K-8, some of the former education fees that were charged separately (i.e., computer fee, Fast Direct fee, religion books) will now be included with the tuition fee. For 2019-2020:

One Student Only K-8 - \$1,350

Two or More Students K-8 Family Maximum- \$2,480

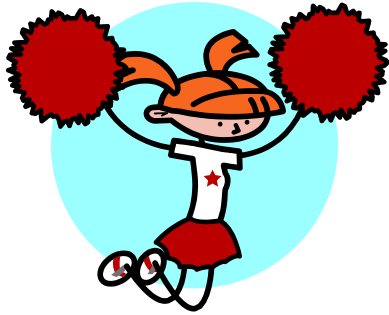
