TUITION SCHEDULE FOR 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

St. John's Voters have approved a 4% increase to the school tuition fees for next fall. Pre-Kindergarten tuition will remain the same. For grades K-8, some of the former education fees that were charged separately (i.e., computer fee, Fast Direct fee, religion books) will now be included with the tuition fee.

For 2019-2020: One Student Only K-8 - \$1,350; Two or More K-8 Family Maximum- \$2,480

For the 2019-2020 school year, we will be using TADS (Tuition Aid Data Services) to determine financial grant amounts. You can find the applications online at www.mytads.com **It is also linked to our school website School or FastDirect/TADS page. This is available to all families, PreK-8. Anyone may apply!**
